RESOLUTION NO. 2021R-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ODESSA, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE ODESSA POLICE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,600.00; AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO COMMIT TO A CASH MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,600.00 FROM THE DONATIONS FUND; AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 - \$13,600.00 AS REVENUE FOR THE ODESSA POLICE DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, sent notification that the Odessa Police Department is eligible to apply for \$13,600.00 in the 2021 Bulletproof Vests Partnership Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a 50% cash match; and

WHEREAS, the Odessa Police Department will contribute a cash match from the donations fund in the amount of \$13,600.00 for the purchase of thirty four (34) bulletproof vests for the Odessa Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Odessa understands and agrees to abide by the terms and conditions set forth in the Grant Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ODESSA, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Odessa authorizes the Odessa Police Department to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$13,600.00.

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Odessa authorizes the Chief of Police to transfer \$13,600.00 from the donations fund into the appropriate City account and hereby appropriates said total of \$27,200.00 for the purpose of purchasing bulletproof vests.

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Odessa accepts the terms and conditions of the U.S. Department of Justice 2021 Bulletproof Vests Partnership Grant Program.

Section 4. That the City Council of the City of Odesa hereby authorizes the expenditure of awarded grant funds, in an amount not to exceed the granted amount, for said purchase.

Section 5. That the City Manager is authorized to execute any documents necessary to implement this resolution.

Section 6. That this resolution shall be effective at the time of its adoption.

If your unit of local government is eligible for an award of \$25,000 or more, please ensure an application is submitted under Category 2 (\$25,000 and above).

Deadlines:

The [Grants.gov](#) deadline to apply for funding under is 11:59 p.m. eastern time on **July, 26, 2021**, and the [JustGrants](#) deadline to apply is 11:59 p.m. eastern time on **August, 9, 2021**.

Applications must be submitted by the stated deadline, regardless of whether the [Certifications and Assurances by Chief Executive \(CE\) of Applicant Government](#) has been completed and attached. **BJA will add a withholding of funds special condition to the award for any missing or incomplete items; including the aforementioned CE certification.**

Areas of Emphasis:

This Agreement is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2021, by and between the COUNTY OF ECTOR, acting by and through its governing body, the Commissioners Court, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the CITY OF ODESSA, acting by and through its governing body, the City Council, hereinafter referred to as CITY, both of Ector County, State of Texas, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, this Agreement is made under the authority of Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party; and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and COUNTY agree as follows:

Section 1.

CITY agrees to pay COUNTY a total of \$10,912.00 of JAG funds, contingent upon award of the JAG funds in the total amount of \$83,938.00. In the event that an amount less than \$83,938.00 is awarded to the CITY and COUNTY under the JAG Program, the amount allocated to each entity will be reduced proportionately.

Section 2.

COUNTY agrees to use \$10,912.00 for overtime pay until funds are exhausted, but in no case for longer than four years from the receipt of the grant by the CITY.

Section 3.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Texas Tort Claims Act.

Section 4.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Texas Tort Claims Act.

Section 5.

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

Section 6.

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

Section 7.

In the event that no funds are awarded to CITY under the JAG Program, CITY shall have no obligation to furnish funds to COUNTY under this agreement.

Section 8.

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.
